

What to expect on Sundays

- Please arrive early!!
 - For the 8am service come to the outside chapel door from 7:30-7:50
 - For the 10:30am service please arrive at the Tower entrance of the Church between 10:00-10:20am.
- The King St door to the Parish House will remain locked. Please enter the Church/Chapel through the Churchyard.
- Masks are MANDATORY.
- Your temperature will be recorded upon entry along with your name and phone number. (Do not come to Church with any symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, fever, etc.)
- There are hand sanitizer dispensers at the entrances, please make use of these.
- Hand Sanitizer is also available in your pew rack.
- There are green crosses posted in the Chapel and Church where you may sit. Families/couples may sit together. Please maintain 6ft between you/your family and the next worshipper in the pews.
- Bulletins will be available for pick-up and a QR Code will be available so that you can access the bulletin on your smart device if you prefer.
- There will be no congregational singing.
- We will not have our normal meet & greet version of the Peace; you may offer peace in the form of hugs and kisses to immediate family members only. Please remain in your pews.
- There will be no passing of alms basins (offering plates). There will be two stations at which you may drop your tithes and offerings.
- Communion will look different:
 - We will use prepackaged wine/wafer communion cups.
 - Communion will be consumed when you return to your seat
 - Please dispose of plastic communion ware when you exit.
 - The priest will call you up by rows to receive so that social distancing is maintained.
- At 8am, you will be dismissed in a way to preserve social distancing while you exit. At 10:30am, after the organ postlude, you will be dismissed by section so that social distancing may be maintained.
- There will be no coffee hour for the foreseeable future.
